



CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) NOTIFICATION - MARCH 2, 2020

The college administration is monitoring daily the status of the Coronavirus COVID-19.

At this time, we are not planning to suspend campus operations, events or classes. Going forward, we will follow the guidance of the CDC and the TN Dept. of Health, and Giles County Health Department . Our priority is the health and safety of our students, faculty, staff and visitors.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

STAY HEALTHY:

We ask that all members of our community take steps to ensure that we all stay as healthy as possible, including:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid sharing dishes, glasses and utensils.
- Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Especially before eating or preparing food, after going to the bathroom and after you are around someone sick.
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap & water are not available.

IF YOU ARE SICK:

If you are sick, to keep from spreading respiratory illness to others, you should:

- Stay home and do not go to class, dining hall, or campus events if you when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

CLINIC:

Students, please contact the Health Clinic if you are sick. To make an appointment, call 931-424-7338. If the clinic is closed please contact a clinic or physician off campus.

TRAVEL:

Student, faculty or staff members who travel for personal reasons to any country on the CDC's Level 2 and Level 3 warning list may be quarantined away from campus for two weeks after returning to the U.S.
