This is the **type of class** it is.
 LEC = Lecture (a standard classroom setting where a professor instructs to a classroom)
 LAB = Lab (a more hands-on setting)
 HON = Honors (see Catalog for more information on Honors classes)

This is the **title** of the course. It may be abbreviated on your schedule, but you can check the Course Catalog online to get the full title and description!

This is the **Course Number/ID**.
 The first part consists of letters that indicate what academic department the course is in.
 The second part consists of numbers that indicate which class in the department this is.
BOTH the letters and numbers together are the Course Number/ID.

The first and last date of the **semester**, not necessarily the first and last dates of that particular class.

 S1 and S2 classes will list the start and end dates of their respective time frames. Note that S1 and S2 classes occur in the same semester. For example, if you have an S2 class in the FA (Fall) semester, that doesn't mean it's in Spring—it means it's in the latter half of the FA semester!

This is the **instructor's name**. If this field is blank or says TBA or TBD, the instructor has not yet been assigned. Contact the Registrar for more information.

This is the **section** of a class you're in. The section is either a single letter of the alphabet, like it is here, or "S1" or "S2." Often, MMC offers multiple options of the same class at different times, so the Section number indicates which one you are in!

These are the **times** the class meets! The first time is the start, and the second is the end time.

These are the **days** that this course meets.
 MWF = Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays
 MW = Mondays and Wednesdays
 MF = Mondays and Fridays
 TR = Tuesdays and Thursdays
 T = Tuesdays only
 R = Thursdays only
Any single letter indicates that the course only meets one day per week.

This is the number a **credits** that this class is worth. Most classes are 3 credits, though some are more and some are less. Your MMC College Handbook has some great information clarifying credit hours on page 63.

This is the **location** of the class. The letter indicates which building the class meets in. The number indicates which room within that building the class meets in.
 J = JOHNSTON
 M = MARTIN HALL
 A = ANDREWS SCIENCE BUILDING
 GFA = GAULT FINE ARTS BUILDING
 CLC = CHRISTIAN LIFE CENTER (GYM)
 N/A = online course

This is the **total number of credits** you will earn at the end of the semester if you successfully complete all the classes listed here.
 MMC requires 121 credit hours by the end of 4 years for a degree.
