The Assistant Director of Sports Medicine will report to and assist the Director of Sports Medicine with the organization, assessment and delivery of medical care for student-athletes. The pair will serve the 15 intercollegiate sport teams of Martin Methodist College as assisted by the local medical community. The duties will include, but not limited to: 1). Assist with administration of pre-season physical exam and health updates for all student-athletes. 2). Perform injury/illness evaluations, provide daily medical treatments, design and implement rehabilitation programs, and provide emergency care for all practices and games. 3). Provide medical support during home and away events and practices including weekend events and travel to off-site practices and competitions. 4). Provide injury/illness evaluation, emergency care, management and treatment, and rehabilitation for intercollegiate student-athletes. 5). Provide necessary medical information regarding athletic injuries/illnesses to the Insurance Coordinator to facilitate claims processing and reimbursement. Review and/or approve medical bills from physicians, hospitals, or other providers to determine accuracy and compliance with NCAA rules as well as Athletic Department policies. 6). Maintain state licensure/registration; comply with BOCATC requirements to maintain certification in good standing; and 7). Maintain high professional ethical standards.
